

CSU is proud to offer a scholarship to the members of Women in Fire. The scholarship will cover up to 60 credit hours toward one online degree program. The scholarship will be applied directly to the recipient's tuition for up to three years or until the completion of the selected online degree program, whichever comes first.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- » Be a member of Women in Fire
- » Meet CSU admission requirements
- » Begin coursework within 90 days of the date of the award
- » Maintain a 2.0 undergraduate GPA or 3.0 graduate GPA
- » Maintain continuous enrollment in degree program

Current CSU students must already meet these requirements to be considered

The scholarship will open on **April 14** and will close **July 13**. The Columbia Southern University scholarship committee will select a recipient, and the recipient will be announced by the by the end of August.
